For OLS Academy Student Paramedics to participate in Term 3, (Ambulance Preceptorship & Clinical Practicum) each student must provide the Academy with evidence of the items listed below. Items currently not on file, are highlighted in yellow.

Students have until the beginning of **April** of each academic year to provide the required evidence, otherwise, the student will not be permitted to participate in the Ambulance Preceptorship or Clinical Practicum. This lack of ability to complete these courses, will result in a non-mastery and subsequent dismissal from the program.

## Requirements for the Ambulance Preceptorship:

To participate in the Ambulance Preceptorship, the student must provide evidence of:

- o At least 19 years of age, prior the Ambulance Preceptorship
- $\circ$  Successful completion of Term 1 and Term 2
- o Successful completion of a Paramedic Physical Abilities Test. (PPAT)
- o A Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector Check
- o Immunization or Proof of Immunity to:
  - o MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
  - Pertussis
  - Tetanus
  - o Diphtheria
  - Hepatitis B
  - o Varicella
- o Proof of a negative result on a Two-step TB Test
- o Signed Student Confidentiality Agreement with applicable stakeholder
- o Signed Student Waiver & Release of applicable stakeholder
- N95 Mask Fit Test completed
- o Class 4 Driver's Licence & CEVO-4 Training:
  - o If the student wishes to drive during their preceptorship experience
- All tuition and fees paid



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## **Requirements for Clinical Practicum**

To participate in the Clinical Practicum, the student must provide evidence of:

- Successful completion of Term 1 and Term 2
- Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector
- o Immunization or Proof of Immunity to:
  - o MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
  - Pertussis
  - Tetanus
  - o Diphtheria
  - o Hepatitis B
  - o Varicella
  - o COVID-19 (If planning to complete the Clinical Practicum in Nova Scotia)
- o Proof of a negative result on a Two-step TB Test
- o Completion of all mandatory e-learning modules
- o Review and acknowledgement of all relevant stakeholder policies
- o Signed Education Placement Agreement with applicable stakeholder
- o N95 Mask Fit Test completed
- o All tuition and fees paid
